





1. In 1886 **John Pemberton**, a pharmacist, decided that he wanted to invent something to become successful. He invented a lot of drugs, but he didn't make any money. So he decided to try in the beverage market and with a recipe that is still secret today he invented the most famous drink ever. That's how _____ was born.
2. **George and László Bíró** began to work on designing new types of _____. Bíró fitted it with a tiny ball in its tip that was free to turn in a socket. As it moved along the paper, the ball rotated, picking up ink from the ink cartridge and leaving it on the paper. It was 1938. That's how _____ was born.
3. The word originally meant head massage in several North Indian languages. Both the word and the concept were introduced to Britain from colonial India. The term and service was introduced in Britain by a Bengali entrepreneur Sake Dean Mahomed in 1814, when Dean, together with his Irish wife, opened a _____ bath known as 'Mahomed's Indian Vapour Baths' in Brighton, England. At the beginning English hair stylists boiled shaved soap in water and added herbs to give the hair shine and fragrance. **Kasey Hebert** was the first known maker of this product, and the origin is currently attributed to him.
